Palacio de Figueras enjoys an enviable location in the heart of Asturias. You're close to pretty fishing ports for sublime seafood, one of the world's best surfing beaches, Tapia, and only 1.5 hours from the ancient capital city of Oviedo, a haven for pre-Romanesque architecture.

Inland you can discover the sheer cliffs, vast gorges and dramatic snow-capped mountains of the Picos de Europa, Spain's most spectacular mountain region, where eagles soar and bears and wolves still roam. Or follow in the footsteps of pilgrims along the ancient Camino de Santiago.

Asturias is famed for its abundant gastronomy, particularly cave-matured cheeses and fragrant, crisp ciders. We can arrange a variety of experiences and activities to suit thrill-seekers, food lovers, nature-enthusiasts and peace-seekers before returning you to the palace for a relaxed evening.



The palace is positioned at the very spot where the Cantabrian sea comes inland and separates Asturias from Galicia. Perched high above the Eo estuary there is a timeless, back-to-nature feel as you gaze down at fishing boats and sea birds, and soak up the evocative sights, sounds and smells of the rugged coast.





Rescued from disrepair, the palace underwent a meticulous 11-year restoration carefully overseen by its Spanish owners, the Madera family. The renovation was conducted with a deep respect for the building's original structure and materials, as well as its status as a historic building, which has resulted in the building being designated an Asset of Cultural Interest.

Expert craftspeople with the skills and ability to recreate the beauty of the past whilst incorporating the very best modern comforts were employed throughout. During the works, many materials and original items were either restored using traditional techniques or carefully sourced as an exact replica wherever possible. This painstaking revival has resulted in a remarkable property that will live on for future generations to love and appreciate.

The palace benefits from an internal lift so guests with limited mobility are able to access our rooms and suites.

EXPERIENCES

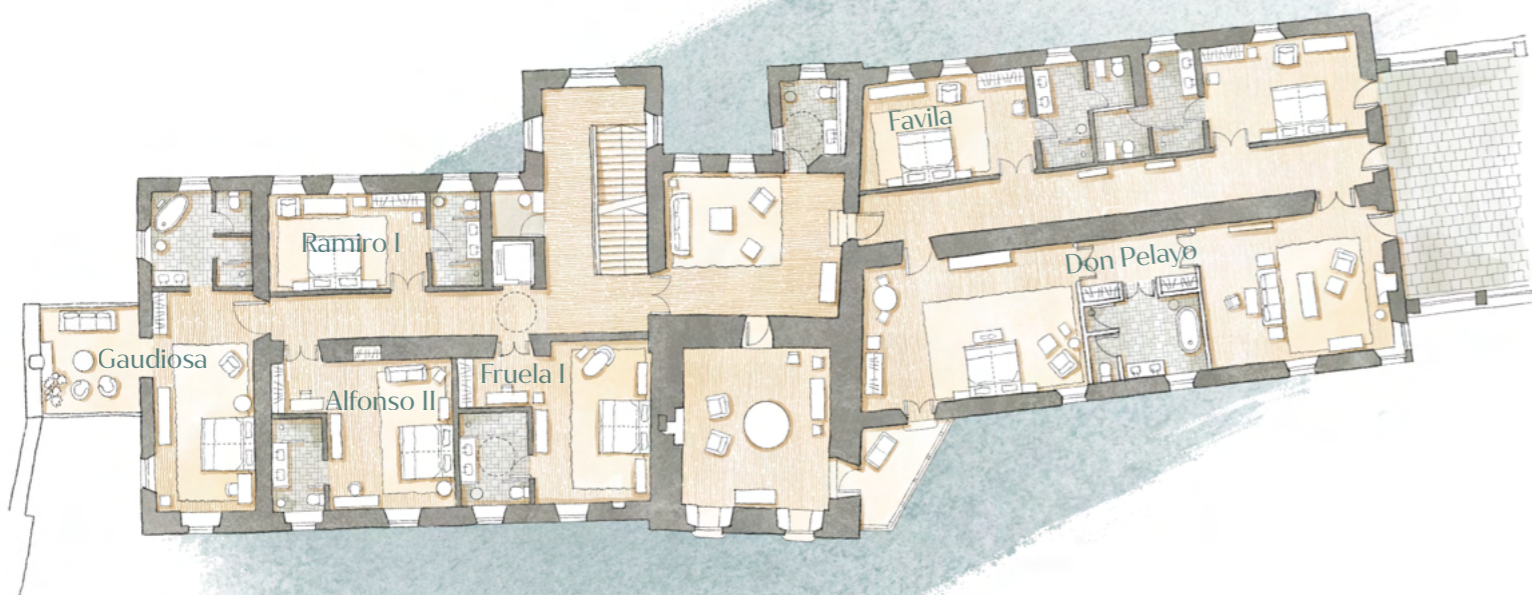

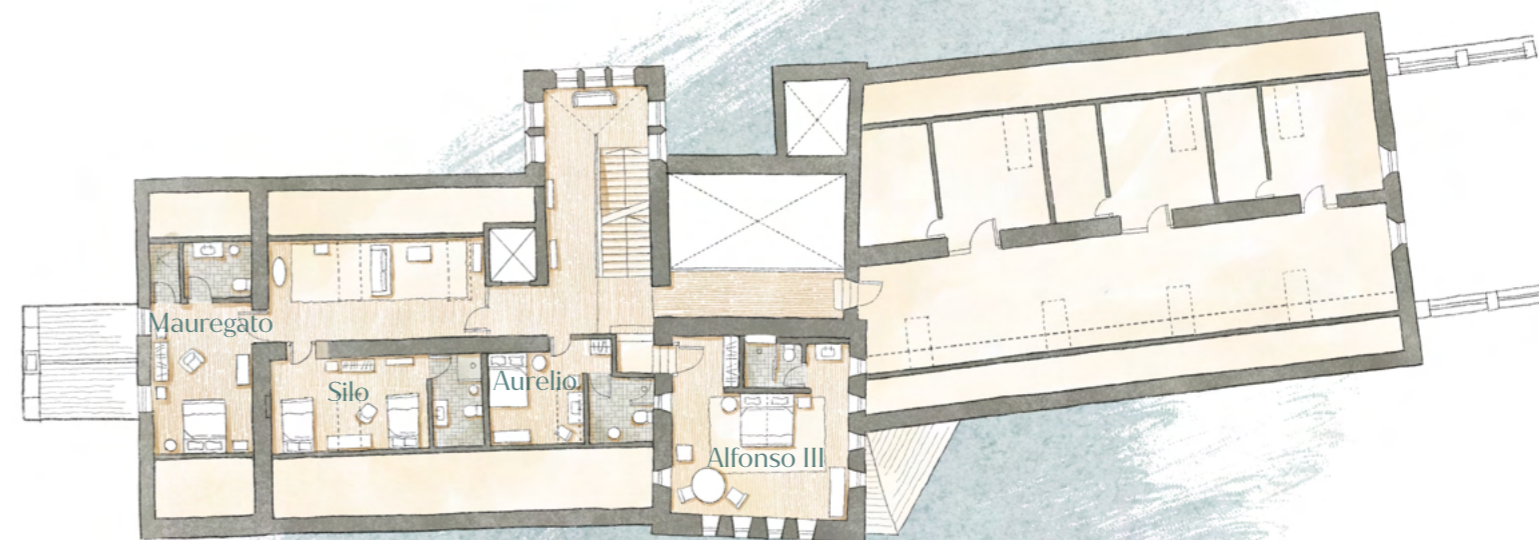
