INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Vestige Son Vell, an original and strikingly beautiful 18th-century manor house set in quiet harmony alongside a clutch of sensitively renovated farm buildings and contemporary one-storey garden suites.

Offering 34 stunning guest bedrooms, each suite and room has been designed for you to unwind in sophisticated seclusion amidst peaceful landscaped gardens. Add to this a warm and natural welcome from our team for a truly cosseting and spoiling stay.

Located twenty minutes from the picturesque port city of Ciutadella and set in rippling Menorcan countryside, the hotel is a ten-minute stroll from Cala Son Vell, a hidden cove on the sunlit Balearic coast, and the centuries-old Camí de Cavalls that ribbons its way around the entire island.

Menorca, the easternmost Balearic island, is the mellower cousin of Mallorca and Ibiza, with dreamy sun-splashed shores of white and golden sand, charming whitewashed villages and rippling hills and fields alive with an air of rural bliss.

Nestled in a rural 180 hectare estate with livestock grazing on fertile fields plus a working farm, the hotel is positioned within a verdant seven hectare enclave of landscaped gardens, citrus trees, olive groves, a rose garden and an organic vegetable garden that feeds the kitchen.

Your time will be well spent floating in the original 18th-century swimming pool or enjoying early morning laps in the new, larger pool, both with poolside bars offering cooling drinks and light-bites to be enjoyed as you stretch out on our custom-made Balinese beds.

The hotel also features two dining options focused on fresh, local produce cooked to perfection: Sa Clarisa for relaxed daytime dining and Vermell for evening à la carte choices. Indoors find an elegant bar where expert mixologists will shake and stir your cocktails to perfection.

The meticulous and delicate restoration process undertaken at Son Vell has preserved much of the marés sandstone, original wood, traditional lime and crafted clay features of the 18th-century manor house and its farm buildings. To compliment the original materials we have designed and commissioned bespoke furniture throughout the hotel.

Using high-quality architectural restoration methods, we undertook a delicate and detailed renovation process to bring these remarkable buildings back to life. During the work, our architects and artisans uncovered two original lime kiln chimneys that are now impressive features within the bar and lounge area.
