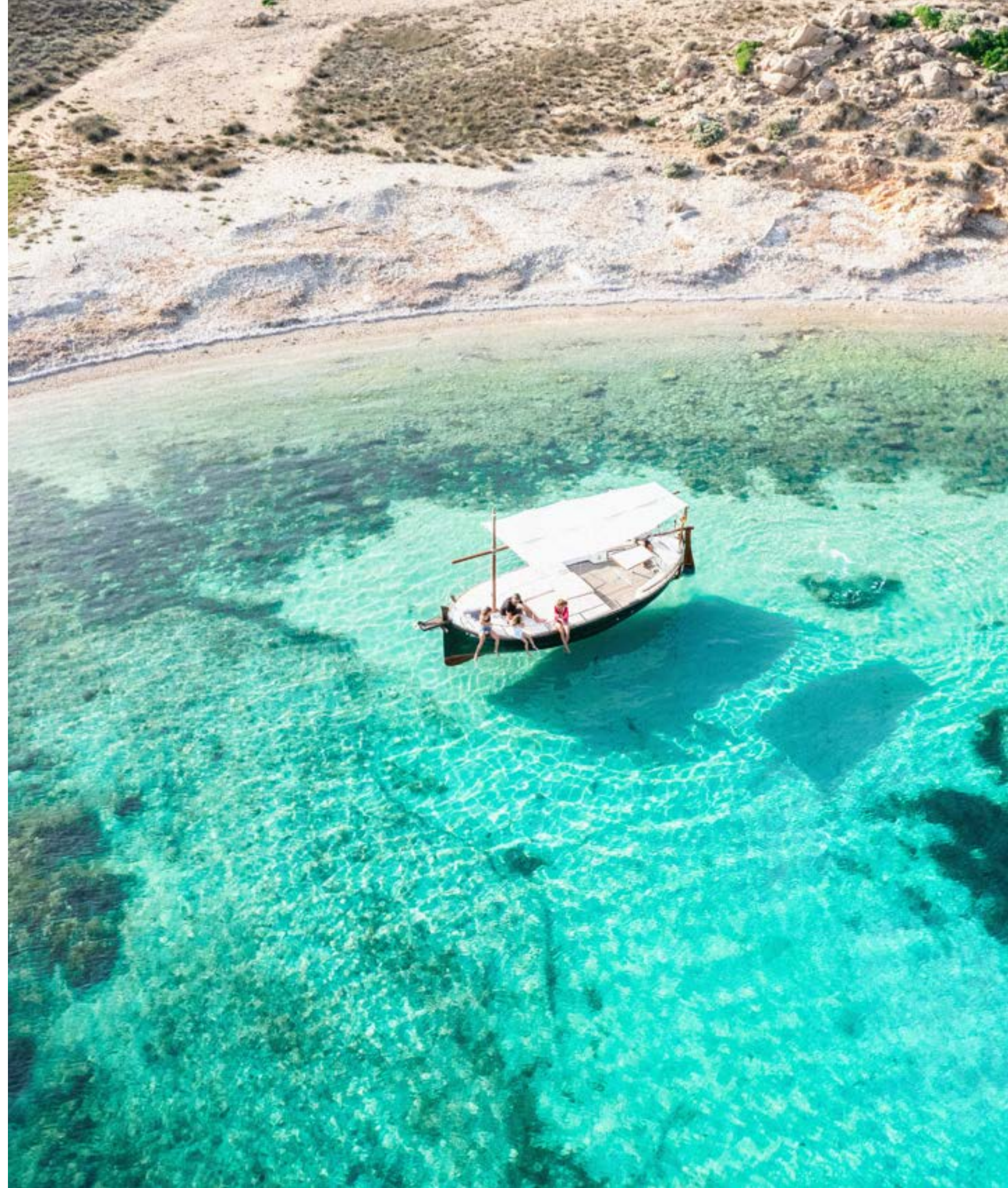
> We can find the right boat for you needs and party size. Prices range from 180 Euros up to 2200 Euros for a full day charter for groups of up to twelve.

Stand Up Paddle Tour

A paddle boarding excursion is a great way to explore the bays and coves of Menorca, and, with the combination of the calm waters of the Mediterranean and an expert instructor, even the absolute beginner can have fun and feel confident in no time.

> Available from 1 June 2024, two-hour tours start from nearby Cala Son Vell, have a maximum group size of eight and cost 60 Euros per person.

MENORCA ON THE WAVES



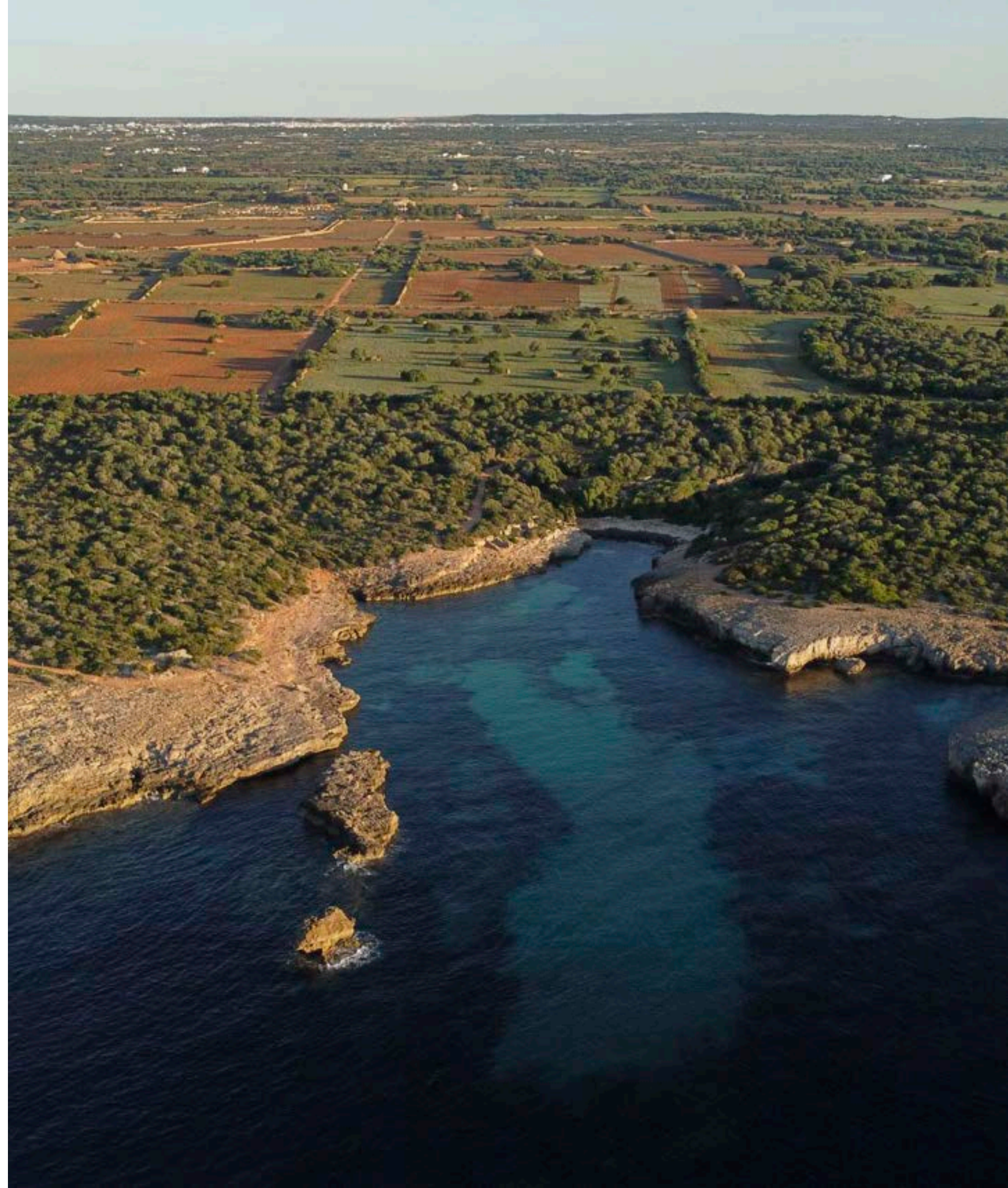
Horse-riding at Son Vell

Horses are inextricably linked with the culture and history of Menorca. They were used to defend the island from as early of the 14th century and the Camí de Cavalls, an ancient bridlepath, encircles the entire island.

It's only natural that Son Vell should offer you the chance to explore the estate on horseback. Whether you're a confident rider or a complete beginner, our team can match you with a horse and an experience that means you explore and enjoy the countryside around you from a new perspective. We offer group, couple or individual lessons, within an arena or out in the 200-hectare estate.

> Prices start at 80 Euros per person, participating in a private individual or group lesson of 90 minutes. Suitable for all ages five years and over. Must be booked by 18:00 the day before.

MENORCA BY LAND



Daybreak or Sunset Camí de Cavalls Horseback Tour

Fringing the island, the Camí de Cavalls pathway gives you access to Menorca's exceptional coastline and stunning landscapes. Seeing these from horseback is using the route as it was originally intended centuries ago. Your expert guide will share the history and secrets of the island as you ride and take you to explore caves and coves off the beaten track. Riding in the morning or at dusk means exceptional light, fewer passers-by and a more comfortable experience in the saddle. The tour either ends with a hearty breakfast or a 'sundowner' with delicious snacks, while you take in unmatched sea views.

> Price per person for a group of up to five participants is 120 Euros for a two-hour tour, and tours for individuals and couples are available on request. Daybreak rides leave Son Vell at 08:00, while evening rides leave the property at 19:00. Recommended for ages 8 and over, but shorter tours are available for groups with children aged 5 and above. Book by 18:00 the day before.



Four Wheel Drive Adventures

If four hooves are not your thing, then why not join an exciting tour on four wheels? The guides we work with have an exceptionally detailed knowledge of Menorca, from its 'Talayotic' or Iron Age history, explaining the structures and remains that are scattered across the island, to the local flora and fauna, some of which is unique to the Menorca. You will be fascinated by them!

The excursion takes you to both the north and the south, with their very different landscapes and geology, passes by pretty villages and beautiful 'calas' before ending with an exclusive sunset visit to Torre del Ram, an impressive medieval tower owned by Vestige Collection, and the chance to take in incredible views out to sea and towards Ciutadella.

> Price for a tour of up to six hours (but can be shorter as required) is 775 Euros, as part of a group of up to six participants. Book a week in advance for July and August and at least four days in advance for the other months.



Art Tour of Ciutadella

Nearby Ciutadella is a gem of a city. Founded in the 4th century, this small port has a rich history; it's been ruled by different cultures across the centuries from the Carthaginians to the Moors, the British and the French, each leaving their mark on the architecture, traditions and cuisine. Pretty and compact, it's photogenic and varied – home to interesting monuments, but also great restaurants, stylish boutiques and the studios of artisans and artists.

We offer a private tour of Ciutadella exploring the contemporary creative scene. Taking in a gallery and local foundation and giving you the chance to meet an artist in studio and view a private collection accompanied by a specialist guide, this excursion is a memorable way to understand the vibrancy of art in Menorca today.

> Private art tours of approximately four hours are 660 Euros for two people, including refreshments.

Garden Dining Experiences

Shady and fragrant, the seven acres of gardens at Son Vell feature pretty ‘garden rooms’ where our team can create an intimate setting for an exquisite dining experience. Choose from two menu options, created with the freshest, locally sourced ingredients and expertly put together by our award-winning chef Joan Bagur and his team.

Our four-course ‘Fresh in the Garden’ menu features delicious ‘amuse bouche’ using produce from the Vestige estates, elegant and light starters, freshly caught fish or a succulent lamb shoulder as a main and a dessert that is both refreshing and spoiling. There’s a delicious vegetarian and vegan option too, which equally inventive and indulgent.

Lovers of seafood can truly spoil themselves with the ‘Menu Langosta’, a fabulous four-course feast featuring the freshest locally caught lobster as the star ingredient, in dishes such as lobster tail in a caviar beurre blanc and Menorcan ‘caldereta’, a rich lobster and rice stew. Naturally this ends with a luscious dessert!

> The ‘Fresh in the Garden’ is available for 120 Euros per person including a welcome cocktail and mineral water, with a wine pairing at 60 Euros. The exceptional ‘Menu Langosta’ is priced at 320 Euros per person, including the apéritif and water, with our sommelier’s suggested wine pairing at 120 Euros per person.
